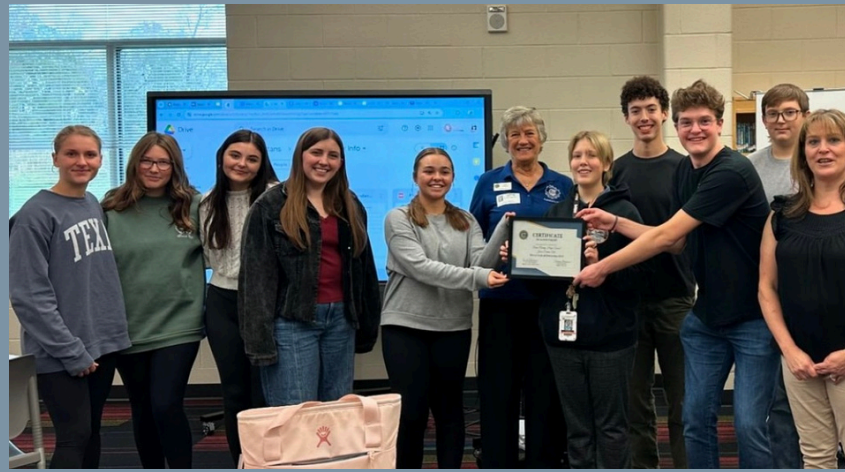


Spotlight: Davie High School

New Regional Logos Now Available!

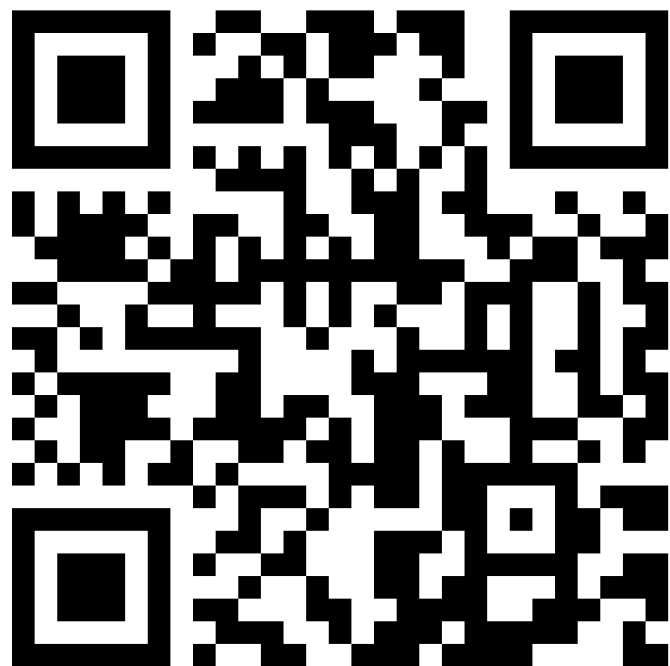

Scholarship Opporturtunities

The scholarship opportunities through Jr. Civitan are endless. To focus on one type lets look at All In Summit. At the Summit, five participants will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship through a drawing. Everyone attending receives one entry, with additional entries based on fundraising levels: Seaman earns one entry, Lieutenant earns two, Commander earns four, Captain earns five, and Admiral earns six. "Rankings" are based on money fundraised. Plus, for every \$500 raised beyond the \$1,500 mark, participants gain an extra entry into the drawing.

This annual gathering offers a blend of activities that emphasize Junior Civitan's core values: fellowship, education, and service.

During the summit, you all will have the opportunity to connect with fellow members through, creating bonds that last long after the weekend ends. The environment is fun and collaborative, providing young people with the chance to interact with peers who share their passion for positive change. The emphasis on team-building helps foster a sense of community among participants, building friendships that span across states and last a lifetime.

Education is another key focus of the summit, where you can gain valuable insights into leadership, civic responsibility, and community service. The event features speakers who are leaders in their fields, including Nick Tokman from Discovery Channel's Deadliest Catch who will speak on overcoming all of the distractions and obstacles that get in the way of owning who you are, so you can achieve your definition of success.

In the spirit of service, the summit raises funds for the CIRC, a world-leading research center dedicated to advancing knowledge in intellectual and developmental disabilities. This fundraising component allows you to contribute directly to meaningful research.

The All In Summit encapsulates the Junior Civitan mission, giving you a weekend packed with learning, growth, and fun so you can go out and Make the World a Better Place! By bringing together young leaders to share experiences, foster connections, and take steps to make the world a better place, the All In Summit remains an essential event for Junior Civitans looking to make a lasting impact so if you haven't already, start fundraising. **If you raise \$1000 by December 13, you will get a free flight to the All-In Summit.**
